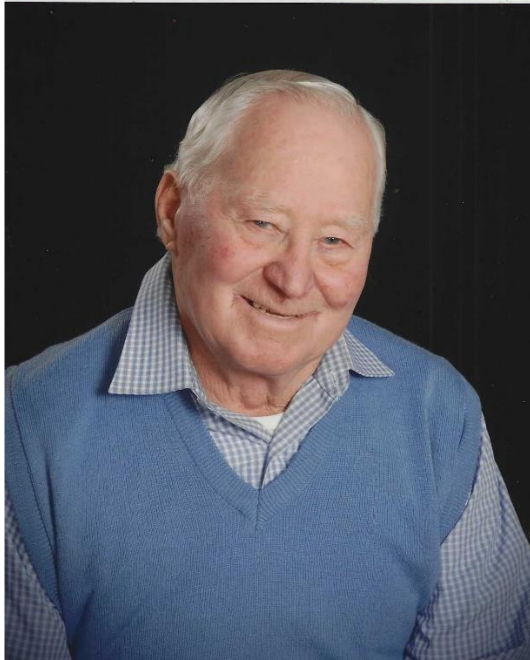


Martin E. Seichter, 92, of Boyd, passed away peacefully with his family by his side at home.
